# Future Dreams Hats & Flowers

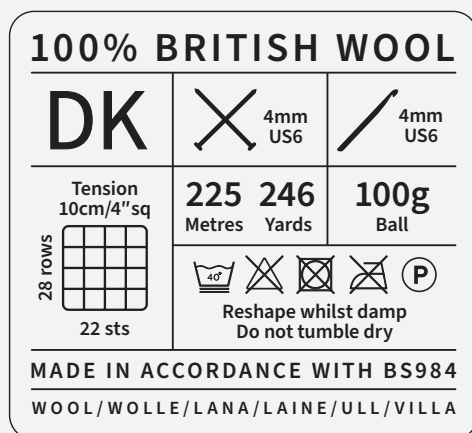
## Tension

It is essential to work to the stated tension in order to achieve the desired fabric and garment size. You should always start by knitting/crocheting a tension square before creating the full garment.

If you have fewer stitches than stated you will need to go down needle/hook sizes until the correct tension is achieved. If you have more, you will need to go up needle/hook sizes. Please check individual patterns for tension before starting the garment.

## Finishing

We recommend using mattress stitch for seaming your Hat. Once your Hat is completed it is essential to block your work. Pin your Hat out to the size stated in the pattern, cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.

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# Future Dreams Knitted Hat

## Knitted Hat with Flower

Skill Level: ● ● ○ ○ ○

Yarn: West Yorkshire Spinners – ColourLab DK



Future Dreams (1197)

1 x 100g

### Measurements

**Note:** The Hat is intended to be fitted and will stretch slightly when worn.

#### To Fit Head Circumference

cm	50
in	19¾

#### Actual Hat Circumference

(measured above rib)

cm	17
in	43

### Equipment

One pair 3.25mm (UK10/US3) knitting needles

One pair 4mm (UK8/USA6) knitting needles

### Tension

22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm (4in) over stocking stitch using 4mm needles or size required to give correct tension.

If there are less sts to 10cm than number stated, change to a finer needle. If there are more sts to 10cm than number stated, change to a larger needle.

**It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success.**

### Hat

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 102 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** \*P2, K2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, P2.

These 2 rows set 2x2 rib, work 9 rows more.

**Row 12 (WS):** P5, P2tog, (P8, P2tog) 9 times, P5. 92 sts.

**Change to 4mm needles**, beg with a knit row and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Hat measures 18cm from cast on edge, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

### Shape Crown

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, (K2tog, K5) 13 times. 79 sts.

**Row 2 and every foll alt row:** Purl.

**Row 3:** K1, (K2tog, K4) 13 times. 66 sts.

**Row 5:** K1, (K2tog, K3) 13 times. 53 sts.

**Row 7:** K1, (K2tog, K2) 13 times. 40 sts.

**Row 9:** K1, (K2tog, K1) 13 times. 27 sts.

**Row 11:** K1, (K2tog) 13 times. 14 sts.

**Row 13:** (K2tog) 7 times. 7 sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

### Flower

Using 4mm (US6) needles, cast on 168 sts.

**Rows 1–3:** Knit.

**Row 4:** Purl.

**Row 5:** Knit.

**Row 6:** Purl.

**Row 7:** \*K6, drop left hand needle towards the back of work and bring up the front to create a twist; rep from \* to end.

**Row 8:** Purl.

**Row 9:** K2tog to end. 84 sts.

**Row 10:** P2tog to end. 42 sts. Cast off.

Thread tapestry needle, spiral into flower shape and secure with several stitches at back of flower.

### Making Up

Join back seam. Attach Flower to Hat as shown.

Pin out Hat to size, cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.

# Future Dreams Crochet Hat

## Crochet Hat with Flower

Skill Level: ● ● ○ ○ ○

Yarn: West Yorkshire Spinners – ColourLab DK



Future Dreams (1197)

1 x 100g

### Measurements

**Note:** The Hat is intended to be fitted and will stretch slightly when worn.

### To Fit Head Circumference

cm	50
in	19¾

### Actual Hat Circumference (measured above rib)

cm	15¾
in	40

### Equipment

One 4mm (UK8/US6) crochet hook  
Tapestry needle

### Tension

21 trs and 10 rows to 10cm (4in) over treble pattern using 4mm hook or size required to give correct tension.

If there are less sts to 10cm than number stated, change to a finer hook. If there are more sts to 10cm than number stated, change to a larger hook.

**It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success.**

### Hat

Using 4mm crochet hook, make 87ch loosely.

**Row 1 (RS):** 1tr into 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, 1tr into each ch to end, turn. 85tr.

**Row 2:** 3ch (3ch count as 1tr through), 1tr into each tr to end, turn.

Row 2 sets treble pattern.

Work in patt until Hat measures 16cm, ending with RS row facing for next row.

### Shape Crown

**Row 1:** 3ch, (tr2tog, 1tr into next 2tr) 21 times, turn. 64tr.

**Row 2:** 3ch, (tr2tog, 1tr into next 1tr) 21 times, turn. 43tr.

**Row 3:** 3ch, (tr2tog) 21 times, turn. 22tr.

**Row 4:** 3ch, (tr2tog) 10 times, 1tr into last tr, turn. 12tr.

**Row 5:** 3ch, (tr2tog) 5 times, 1tr into last tr. 7tr. Fasten off leaving 20cm tail.

Using 20cm tail, gather up through rem 7tr, draw up and fasten off.

### Edging

Using 4mm crochet hook and with RS facing, work 1 row of dc evenly round lower edge.

**Next row:** Working from left to right, work 1dc into each dc to end. Fasten off.

### Flower

Using 4mm (US6) hook, ch145.

**Row 1 (RS):** Dc into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, dc in each ch to end, turn. 144 sts.

**Row 2:** \*Ch5, miss 5 sts and dc into next st, rep from \* to end of row, turn.

**Row 3:** \*Work 10tr into ch-sp, sl-st into dc, rep from \* to end, working last sl-st in ch-sp 24 petal groups.

Fasten off leaving a long tail. Thread tapestry needle, spiral from one end to form flower and secure in place with several stitches.

### Making Up

Join back seam. Attach Flower to Hat as shown.

Pin out Hat to size, cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.
